Requirements of EPA/HUD LEAD BASED PAINT RULES

Housing built before 1978 may contain lead-based paint. Lead from paint, paint chips, and dust can pose health hazards if not taken care of properly. Lead exposure is especially harmful to young children and pregnant women. Before renting pre-1978 housing, landlords must disclose the presence of known lead-based paint and lead-based paint hazards in the dwelling. Tenants must also receive a Federally Approved pamphlet on lead poisoning prevention. Finally, an acknowledgment form similar to this form will have to be executed and provided to the Tenant with each lease. For existing leases, these requirements must be met upon lease renewal (including any rental adjustment.) To facilitate compliance with the lead-based paint rule, please complete the following information and return this form to us with copies of any appropriate documentation.
